

1 Internet Explorer

- **1.1** How to suppress the "Do you want to allow this webpage to access your clipboard?" prompts
 - 1. In IE, go to Tools -> Internet Options.



2. Click on the Security tab, then select the Internet zone, then click "Custom level..."
